A little story telling about my last neighborhood, my steps on colors synthesis

Place de la République (formerly Place du Château-d'Eau) is a square of 3.4 ha² located on the border of **the 3rd**

10th and 11th arrondissements of Paris. **Georges Méliès** neighbourhood

The square is served by seven major streets. Five metro lines from Paris cross each other, making the République station an important node of connections.

The place takes its present form as part of the transformations of Paris during the Second Empire.

In 1855 is declared of public utility the construction of a barracks behind the water tower.

The barracks of Prince Eugène, later named Barracks of Château-d'Eau, then Barracks Verines, is built by Degrove, on the site of the former summer Vauxhall and diorama of Louis Daguerre where Jacques Daguerre, one of the inventors of photography, gave his fifteen minute performances.

The place takes its current name in 1879.

The same year, the competition organized for the installation of a great monument dedicated to the Republic proclaimed again is won by the Morice brothers: Leopold for the statuary and Charles for the basement.

The entirety of the bronze cast iron is made by the foundry of Thiébaud et Fils Art in 1883.

Two inauguration ceremonies take place on July 14, 1880 with the plaster model, on July 14, 1883 with the definitive bronze version.

The monument consists of a colossal bronze statue of Marianne 9,50 meters high on a stone base 15 meters high where allegories of Liberty, Equality and Fraternity are based.

On October 3, 2016, modules dedicated to skateboarding will be installed, which will be integrated in the square for an indefinite period.

This project is initiated by Volcom.

Volcom has been a California sport action brand since 1991.

Specializing in surf, skateboard and snowboard clothing and accessories.

The brand is known for its slogan Youth Against Establishment.

The first Volcom store opens November 2, 2002 in Los Angeles.

Since then, many Volcom stores have sprung up.

Volcom products are distributed in independent specialty stores, specialty chain stores and department stores, as well as Volcom.com (US and Canada)

The company also has a growing distribution network, made up of many owned stores around the world.

Volcom has shops in Europe, North America, Indonesia, Japan, South Africa, Australia and South America.

Since 1995, Volcom has been offering artists a platform for them to express themselves through the Featured Artists product line.

Let's Kids Ride Free is a Volcom campaign to make skateboarding, surfing and snowboarding competitions free of charge so that young people can practice their talent and have a unique experience.

Volcom has a team of international male and female athletes who are representative advertising images of the brand.

After a long process of design, planning and production, Volcom worked with Sterling Projects to replace the skateboard modules at Place de la République in Paris.

Ten months ago ..

An impressive pyramid of more than 12m long and two aligned granite benches were specially designed to fit the place while the old buildings found a new temporary house at the Place De La Bastille.
